


WATCH OUT! On the Road

Roads are very dangerous places. When you're walking along them, it's important to be careful.






Stay on the sidewalk, next to an adult. What could happen if you ran ahead?


Always choose the safest place to cross the road. One good place is at a traffic light.






You push the button to change the lights. How do you know when it is safe to go?








This is a nuisance if you want to cross quickly to see a friend or to buy an ice cream.

the road. What could happen if you do?






When the road is empty, walk straight across, and look and listen as you go.

the driver ...




the passengers ...
